

Scholarship Details

This scholarship is possible thanks to the generous support of John Lomax. Based on the belief that work experience complements academic studies and prepares students to be successful upon graduation, this scholarship is designed to encourage UNCG students to participate in internships.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

During the year for which the scholarship is awarded, candidates must:

- Be an undergraduate student enrolled in a degree program at UNCG and have completed 60 credit hours.
- Maintain a minimum GPA of 3.2.
- Be a permanent resident of Guilford County (not just due to enrollment at UNCG).
- Complete an internship with a minimum duration of 120 hours.

Other considerations:

- The internship must be for academic credit.
- The internship must be confirmed by the employer in an email/letter submitted with the application.
- A statement of proposed learning objectives approved by a faculty representative must be submitted with the application.
- Recipients will be expected to provide UNCG Career Services and the Scholarship Donors with a written report/reflection paper at the conclusion of the internship.

SELECTION CRITERIA

In evaluating candidates, priority will be placed on:

- Financial need, including any extenuating financial expenses relating to the internship.
- A strong connection between the internship and the candidate's overall academic and career goals.
- The level of responsibility in the candidate's internship position.
- The quality of the candidate's application, essay and resume. Interviews may also be conducted with finalists.

THE AWARD

- The maximum amount of the award will be \$1,000 per scholarship recipient.
- Students who are awarded the scholarship are expected to write a thank you note to the donor, sharing their plans for the internship and describing how the scholarship will enable their internship experience. This letter must be sent to the donor by way of UNCG Career Services before the funds will be released by UNCG.
- A committee appointed by the Career Services Center will determine the award recipient.
- The Financial Aid Office will distribute the award funds to the recipient in one installment at the beginning of the semester in which s/he completes his/her internship.

DEADLINE

Please refer to the Internship Scholarship Application Form for the current deadline. All application materials must be submitted to UNCG Career Services by this date. Incomplete and late applications will not be considered.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The scholarship recipient must complete the internship described in his/her application. The awarded funds may not be transferred to other internships, except under special circumstances as approved by the Career Services Center.
